Family Events

Parents Night Out (PNO) is usually on the third Saturday of every month. We know that being a parent can be challenging, so we strive to find ways to support parents. During PNO, we feed children (three to eleven years old), play games, do crafts and other fun activities while parents have three hours to themselves. Although teaching and sharing the love of Jesus Christ is important, we search for ways to safely engage and care for families. Annual events like the Easter Egg Hunt, and the Trunk-or-Treat are popular, but there are other events like picnics, family-friendly, interactive worship services, and more, which are inspired by family's interests and needs.



Children's Church

On Sundays at 10 AM, children from 3 through 11 years old, they meet in the Sanctuary with their parents for the Children's Message and then go to the Children's Wing with the Sunday School teacher for a Bible story, songs, lessons in fun, appealing ways. Children return to the Sanctuary before the end of the Sunday service. ***Ask about the nursery for children from birth to 2 years old at the Welcome Desk.***



Confirmation

At the beginning of the year, we offer a special class for children between 11 and 16 years old, that meets regularly until Easter. Each student is paired with a trained mentor for combined whole group and small group lessons and activities about what it means to be a follower of Jesus and to be a part of His church as we grow older and more responsible for our own choices.

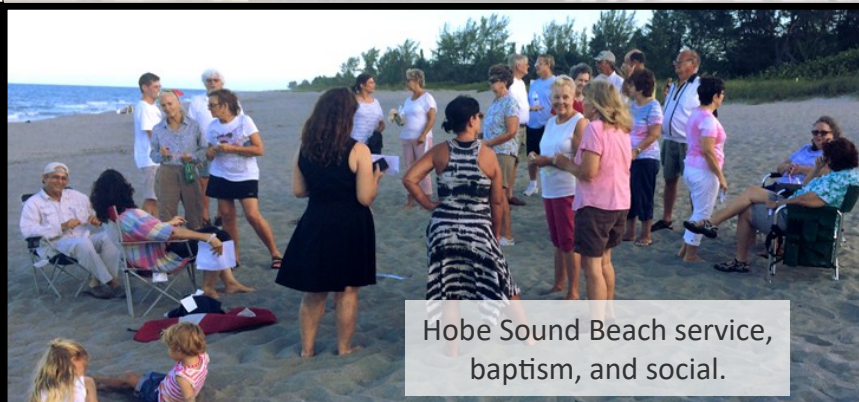
Worship

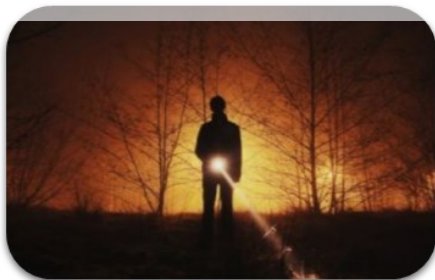

Growth Groups

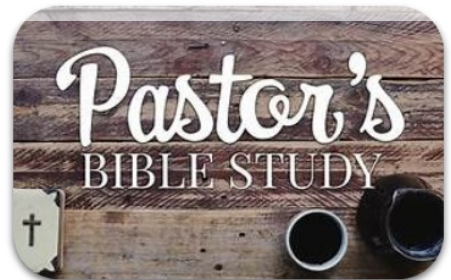

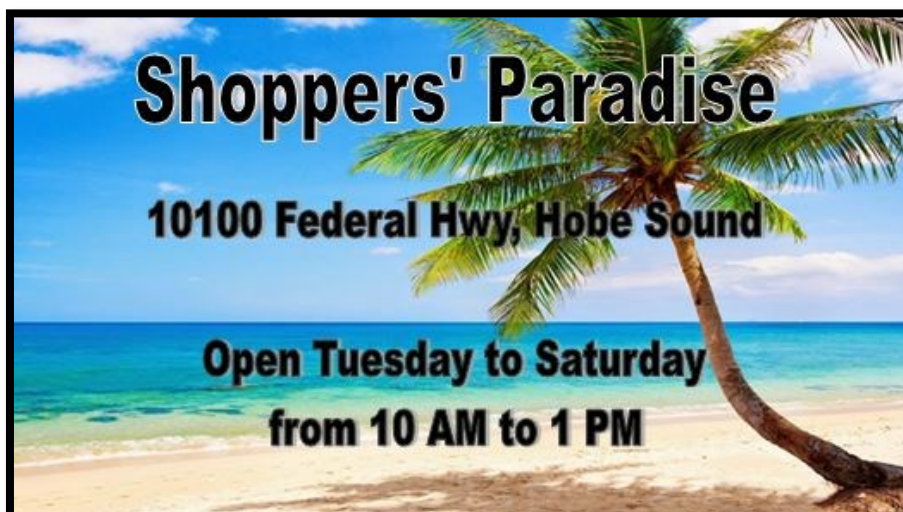
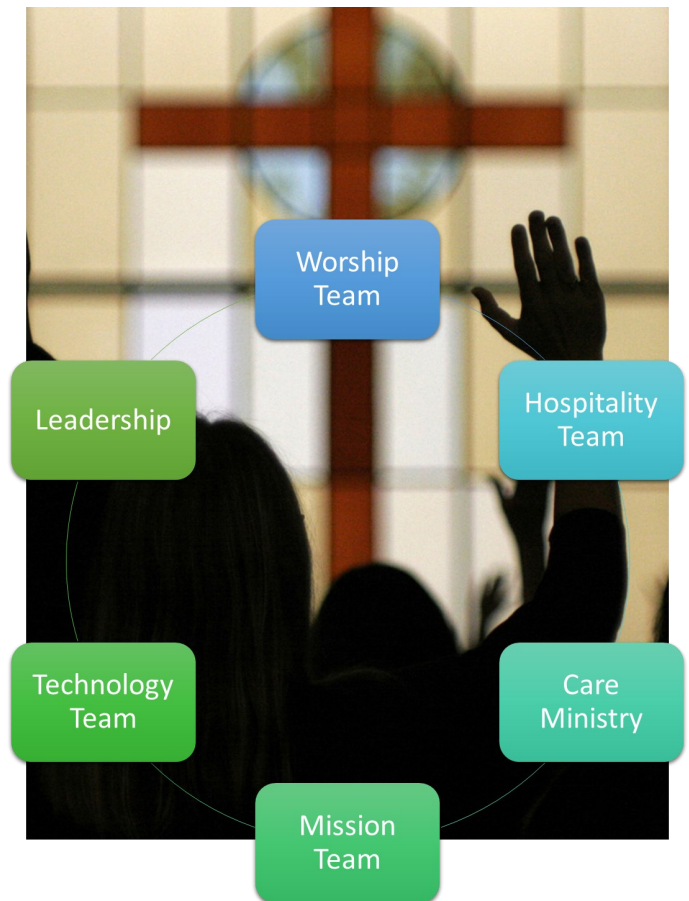
